#### THE WOMEN'S CENTER OF ANYTOWN WILL OBSERVE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH WITH CANDLELIGHT VIGIL

Anytown, MN—The community of Anytown, Minnesota will gather at Anytown Park to remember the victims of domestic violence murdered in 2007, including Mary Johnson of Anytown, who was strangled to death by her former husband on June 15, 2007. A candlelight vigil will be held and community members will speak about the tragic toll of domestic violence. **State Senator Lori Jones** (D-Anytown) is expected to speak at the event, as well as Police **Chief Bob Jackson**, **Mayor Sam Nelson** and **Dr. Kim Baker**, Director of Emergency Services at Anytown Medical Center. Staff members of the Women's Center of Anytown will be available at the vigil to answer questions and provide information about domestic violence.
